THE MECHANICAL ENGINEERING GROUP

The Mechanical Engineering Group is a Technical Group of IPENZ (The Institution of Professional Engineers New Zealand) and has strong links and support from I.Mech.E (The Institution of Mechanical Engineers, London). The objects of the Group are to encourage social and technical liaison between engineers of all levels who have an interest in mechanical technology. The Group, which is currently active in Auckland and Wellington, holds regular meetings of technical interest, and arranges visiting speakers to talk to the Group, as well as visits to works and projects of specific mechanical engineering interest. The formation of branches in other centres is under active consideration.

AM I ELIGIBLE TO BELONG?

Any person with an interest in mechanical engineering is eligible to join the Group. This includes students, technicians, draughtspersons, local body and SOE employees, engineering sales staff, management and consultants. It is not necessary to be a member of IPENZ or I.Mech.E to be eligible to join the group. Benefits of membership include the chance to socialise with other like-minded persons, see a range of mechanical engineering beyond your immediate field, and the opportunity of developing business and technical contacts. The membership subscription is currently \$28.75 per year plus IPENZ administration fee of \$43.70.

ACTIVITIES

Meetings and visits are generally held monthly and are of an informal nature. A social gathering is followed by a speaker. Talks are of broad interest rather than being highly technical and speakers are selected from all branches of the Mechanical Engineering Profession in order to provide a wide-ranging selection of topics. The programme format can be varied to meet the Group and members' requirements. Generally talks are alternated with site visits. These include visits to factories, workshops, industrial suppliers, and large engineering projects. For out-of-town visits, the Group facilitates transport by car-pool or coach. Most years culminate with a social evening to include member's wives and partners.

HOW DO I JOIN?
